Ash Wednesday

- **Definition:**

- » *dies cinerum* (day of ashes)



- 1st day of the season of Lent.

- » Inner repentance.

- » Change of behavior.



History of Lenting

- Job, having been rebuked by God, confesses, "Therefore I despise myself and repent in dust and ashes" – Job 42:6



Lent

- What is lent?
 - » 40 day period of repentance to prepare for the celebration of the resurrection of Christ.



Tradition of Lent

- The Pastor applies ashes to the foreheads of Christians to signify an inner repentance.
- Dusting of ashes expresses sorrow for sins and faults.



WHAT DOES LENT MEAN FOR YOU?

- A time for repentance and sanctification unto Christ.
- A time of renewal, new beginnings.

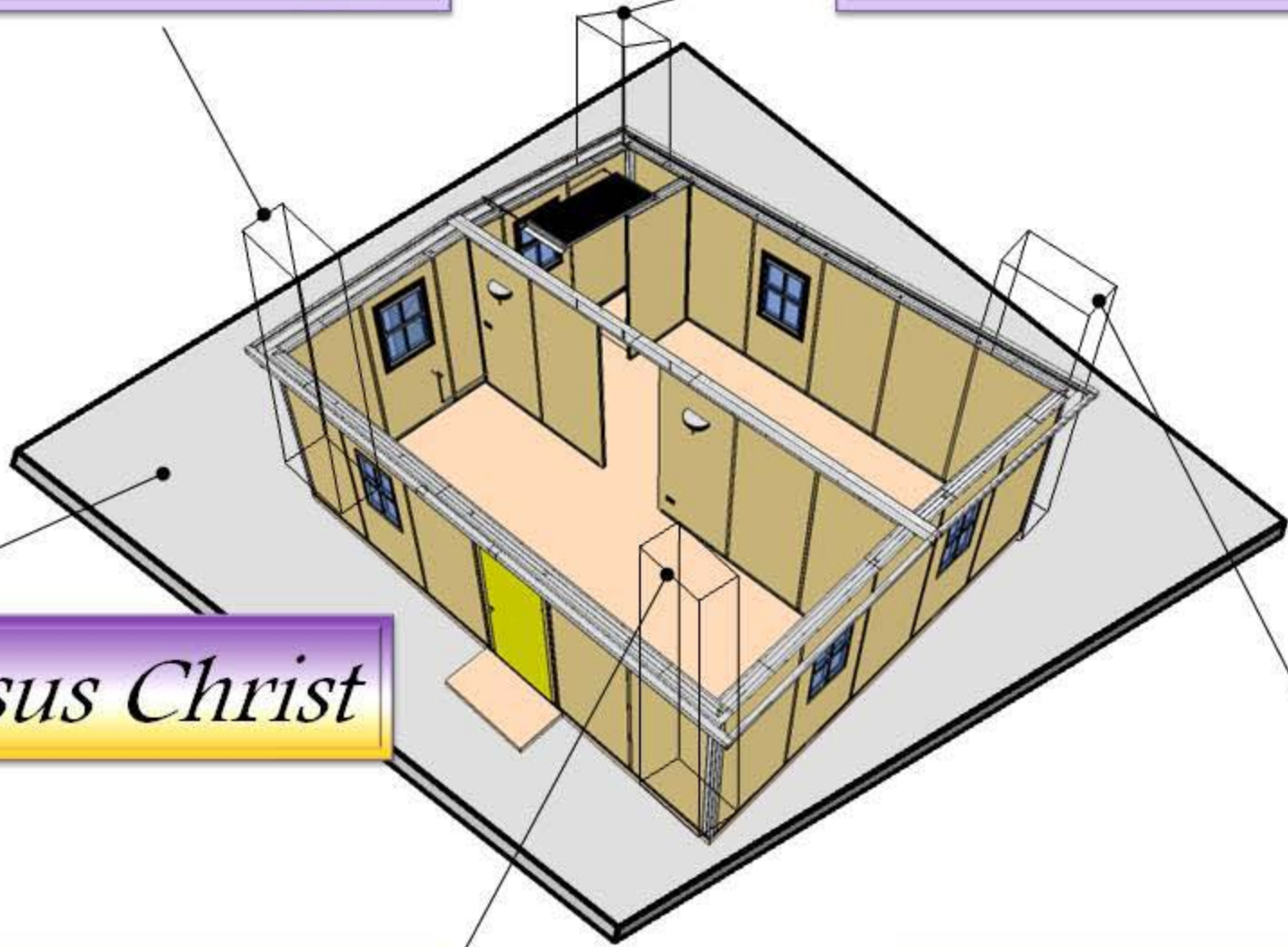

Christology

- **Definition:**

» From Christ and Greek ~ λογία, ~ logia. The field of study within Christian theology which is primarily concerned with the nature and person of Jesus Christ.



Christology (Week 1)

John 1:1

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.



Christology (Week 1)

Hebrews 2:17

Wherefore in all things it behooved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.



Christology (Week 1)

John 1:41

He first findeth his own brother Simon, and saith unto him, We have found the Messiah, which is, being interpreted, the Christ.

Christology (Week 1)

Acts 17:2-3

And Paul, as his manner was, went in unto them, and three Sabbath days reasoned with them out of the scriptures, Opening and alleging, that Christ must needs have suffered, and risen again from the dead; and that this Jesus, whom I preach unto you, is Christ.



Christology (Week 1)

Colossians 2:9-12

For in him dwelleth all the fullness of the Godhead bodily.

And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power: In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ: Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.




Christology (Week 1)

Soteriology (Week 2)

DAY 8 – Ephesians 2:8-9

For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.



Soteriology (Week 2)

DAY 8 – Ephesians 2:8-9 (AMP)

For it is by free grace (God's unmerited favor) that you are saved (delivered from judgment and made partakers of Christ's salvation) through [your] faith. And this [salvation] is not of yourselves [of your own doing, it came not through your own striving], but it is the gift of God; Not because of works [not the fulfillment of the Law's demands], lest any man should boast. [It is not the result of what anyone can possibly do, so no one can pride himself in it or take glory to himself.]



Soteriology (Week 2)

DAY 8 – Ephesians 2:8~9

- **Reflection:** Meditate on the Grace of God.
- **Question:** How do you reflect and respond to the Grace of God in your life daily?



Soteriology (Week 2)

DAY 9 – 1st John 1:9

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness



Soteriology (Week 2)

DAY 9 – 1st John 1:9

- **Reflection:** We need a daily confession for daily cleansing.
- **Question:** How often do you confess your sins to God?



Soteriology (Week 2)

DAY 10 – Romans 6:23

For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.



Soteriology (Week 2)

DAY 10 – Romans 6:23

- **Reflection:** Meditate on the payment for sin.
- **Question:** What has sinning cost you that the blood of Jesus paid for?



Soteriology (Week 2)

DAY 11 – Romans 5:8

But God commendeth
(demonstrated) his love
toward us, in that, while we
were yet sinners, Christ died
for us.



Soteriology (Week 2)

DAY 11 – Romans 5:8

- **Reflection:** Meditate on what Christ did for you on the Cross.
- **Question:** How are you going to demonstrate your love for God because of what He has done for you?

DAY 12 – Romans 3:23

For all have sinned,
and come short of
the glory of God;



Soteriology (Week 2)

DAY 12 – Romans 3:23

- **Reflection:** Meditate on God's goals and requirements for your life.
- **Question:** If sin is missing the mark then what you think is God goals and requirements for your life.



Soteriology (Week 2)

DAY 13 – 2nd Corinthians 5:17

Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.



Soteriology (Week 2)

DAY 13 – 2nd Corinthians 5:17

- **Reflection:** Meditate on being a new creation in Christ.
- **Question:** Do you still have any old habits in your life that should have passed away?

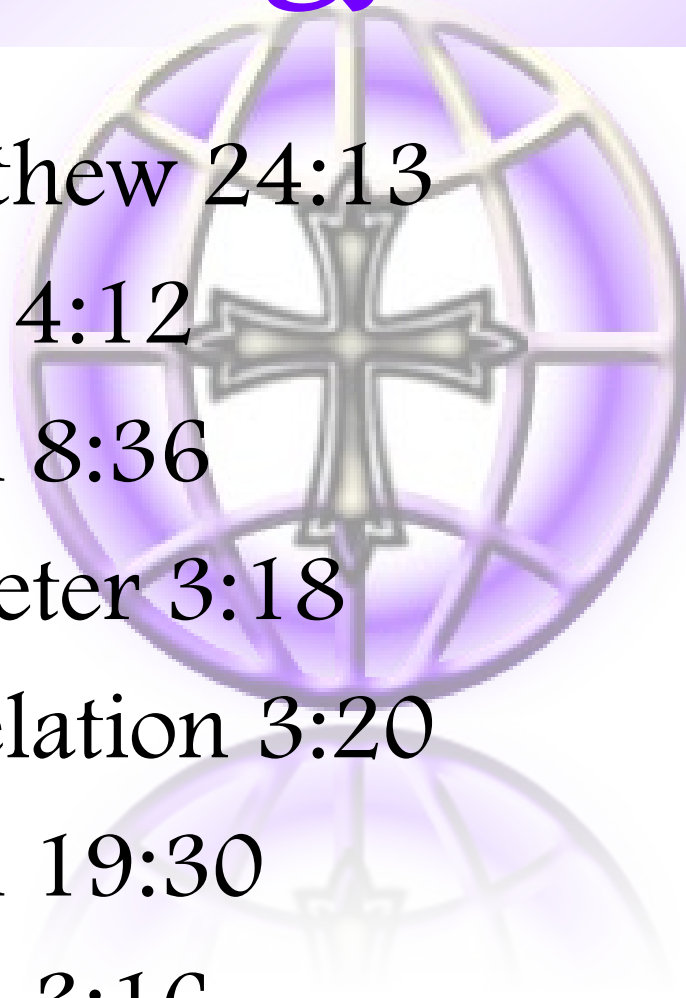

- **Reflection:** Meditate on the finished work of Christ.
- **Question:** Are you operating from the finished work of Christ in your life?

DAY 21 – John 3:16

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.



Ecclesiology (Week 3)

DAY 21 – John 3:16

- **Reflection:** Meditate on the Love of God.
- **Question:** God gave his Son to world so you would not perish but have everlasting life what are you giving to the world?
