### SERMON NOTES: GETTING BACK ON TRACK

#### ..: Scriptural References ..:

- Psalms 73:1-14; 37:1-7
- Galatians 6:6-9

#### ..: Terminology ..:

- **Feet:** An analogical reference of how stable you are, with respect to this text.
- **Trust:** Having full confidence in the authority of God. (Hebrew Reference)
- **Due:** That which is opposed to someone else but is specific to your season.

#### ..: OUTLINE ..:

**Note To Self:** You cannot find your happiness in the world.

- During Tough Times When You Feel Like Giving Up...
  - Think about the people that are not saved.
  - They are looking to you, The Saved, as The Example.
  - They're watching for your victory or your fall.
  - But you determine what they will see.

### 5 KEYS TO GETTING BACK ON TRACK

#### 1) Trust In The Lord (Psalms 37:3)

- a. "Trust", with respect to this text, is the Hebrew reference for having full confidence in the authority of God.
- b. We must have the understanding that God is STILL in control.

#### 2) Make Yourself Happy (Psalms 37:4)

- a. Don't let the devil steal your joy!
- b. Let God be your delight.
- c. Simply enjoy, being saved... Something that was not always promised to you, but is now.

#### 3) Commit Your Way Unto The Lord

- a. Roll up your life and put it in God's hands.
- b. "Roll up" in God's authority.
- c. It is God's job to bring it to past.
  - i. It's your joy to PRAISE HIM!
- d. The steps of a good man are rolled up in the Lord.
- e. Roll your cares up in the Lord.

### 4) Rest In God (Psalms 37:7)

- a. Wait on God! – Patiently...

### 5) Don't Be Weary While Sewing Into The Spirit (Galatians 6:6-9)

- a. Sew into the right ground, sew into the spirit.
- b. "Due" is a Hebrew reference, with respect to this text, for that which is opposed to someone else – but specific to your season. So as the saying says, "in due season..."
